Q1 What kind of school is Gunseo Global School?

Gunseo Global School is Gyeonggi-do's first integrated public charter school for k-12, and is a global communication-specialized school. Academic background is accepted same as in general public schools.

Q2 What are the recruitment targets?

According to the Gunseo Global School Plan, students who live in Siheung will be recruited, and Korean and foreign students (China, Russia) will be selected at a ratio of around 5:5.

Q3 What is the tuition fee for International Gunseo Global School?

Students at Gunseo Global School are eligible for compulsory education, so basic admission fees, tuition fees, textbook purchases, and meals are provided free of charge, just like general public schools.

Q4 How is after-school care operated?

The 'School Care Center', in cooperation with local governments, the Office of Education, and schools, will be operated from after school until 19:00. (The lower grades will be selected first)

Q5 Do I have to be good at foreign languages to enter?

Since the learning-coaching allows students to choose classes in consideration of their interests and characteristics, students will be provided an education according to their own learning progress.

Q6 How are the Global Language Arts (GLA) classes in Gunseo different from general foreign language classes?

Gunseo Global School offers GLA classes from the first grade. Unlike existing function-oriented language education, communication skills will be focused through various programs that can utilize the learning such as immersive classes and global language-based projects.

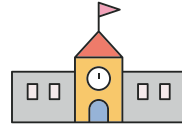
